Ms. Gardner established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Mr. Tatum moved, Mr. Wilson seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A §§43-1-19(h) (2) and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in

favor of the motion were those present who included Board Members Mr. Barber, Mr. McPherson, Mr. Palmer and Mr. Dial.

At the conclusion of the EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

### **APPOINTMENT (S)**

- The Board met with J.T.M. and Advocate to discuss possible reinstatement of his Georgia Pharmacist license.

- The Board was scheduled to meet with C.A.E. and advocate, however the appointment was canceled and rescheduled for the October 2007 Board meeting.
- The Board held a Public Hearing with all interested persons and parties to discuss Rules Chapter 480-10-.18, Chapter 480-15, Chapter 480-22, Rule 480-22-.01, Rule 480-22-.12, and Rule 480-22-.14.
- The Board met with Rosemary E. Ofume, Donatus A. Iriete and their Attorney for a review hearings.

**J.T.M.:** Mr. Tatum made a motion to **approve** J.T.M.'s request for reinstatement of his Georgia Pharmacist license. The case will be forwarded to the Attorney General's Office for a Private Consent Order. Mr. Dial seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**S.H.:** Mr. Wilson made a motion to **approve** S.H.'s request for reciprocity of his license upon passing the MPJE. Mr. Tatum seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

President Gardner established that a quorum was present, and called the Board Meeting to order at 11:20 a.m.

Ms. Gardner made a motion to vote to “**Adopt**”, **Chapter 480-10-18, Utilization of unused Prescription Drugs**. Mr. Tatum seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

## **480-10-18 Utilization of Unused Prescription Drugs**

(1) Definitions:

(a) 'Drug formulary' means any dangerous drug approved by the U.S. Food and Drug

Administration, excluding schedule one through five controlled substances and drugs requiring special storage including but not limited to refrigeration, which drugs must be in the original unit of use container and must have an expiration date of six months or more from the date of transfer to the pharmacy.

(b) 'Health care facility' means an institution which is licensed as a nursing home, intermediate care home, personal care home, home health agency, or hospice pursuant to Chapter 7 of Title 31.

(c) 'Medically indigent person' means:

(i) A person who is Medicaid eligible under the laws of this state; or

(ii) A person:

(A) Who is without health insurance; or

(B) Who has health insurance that does not cover the injury, illness, or condition for which treatment is sought; and whose family income does not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level as defined annually by the federal Office of Management and Budget.

(2) Unused prescription drugs falling within the drug formulary from a health care facility

that are donated by a patient, patient's representative, or guardian pursuant to the Utilization of Unused Prescription Drugs Act may be returned only to a licensed pharmacy approved by the Department of Human Resources. The health care facility must obscure the patient's name, doctor's name, and prescription number from the label on the donated drug container prior to transferring to the pharmacy. The health care facility must package the donated drugs in a sealed container properly addressed and labeled and arrange for a common carrier to pick up and deliver the drugs to the pharmacy, and such common carrier must maintain the drugs in a secure and temperature controlled environment that meets the drug manufacturers recommendations and USP standards.

(3) A licensed pharmacist from the health care facility donating drugs must sign a document verifying that the drugs have been maintained in a secure and temperature controlled environment that meets the drug

manufacturers' recommendations and USP standards. Such documents must accompany the drugs to the receiving pharmacy.

(4) The receiving pharmacy must document the receipt of such donated drugs on a readily retrievable log, and comply with all record keeping requirements of the Board of Pharmacy. All such donated drugs shall be maintained in a separately designated area from the pharmacy's regular stock of drugs, and such storage shall be in an area to ensure drug integrity.

5) Donated drugs can only be dispensed to medically indigent persons pursuant to a valid prescription drug order. The receiving pharmacy must dispense the donated drugs in the original packaging as received from the donating health care facility, and the receiving pharmacy must place a label on the donated drug container in conformance with Board of Pharmacy rules and any other applicable state or federal law. The dispensing records for donated drugs must be maintained in the same manner as all other dispensed drugs and according to Georgia law and Board of Pharmacy Rules.

(6) Dispensing pharmacies of donated drugs may only charge a restocking fee pursuant to Code section 49-4-152.5. Pharmacies and pharmacist shall not be subject to liability for dispensing unused donated drug pursuant to this rule when such services are provided without reimbursement (except the restocking fee), and in good faith and compliance with these rules and law.

The Board wishes to further review Proposed Rules for Adoption. Mr. Tatum seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
