Pat McPherson, President, established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Mr. Prather moved, Mr. Tatum seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A §§43-1-19(h) (2) and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve Ms. Orubele’s request for a Georgia pharmacist license under restrictions of Public Consent Order docketed 2006-0405 plus no PIC and no Pharmacy ownership
