The Georgia State Board of Pharmacy met on August 12, 2009, South University School of Pharmacy, 709 Mall Boulevard, Room 305, Savannah, GA 31406.

Fred Barber established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

Mr. Palmer moved, Mr. Prather seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A §§43-1-19(h) (2) and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board Members, Mr. Wilson, Mr. McPherson, Mr. Tatum, and Mr. Wallace.

At the conclusion of the EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

Appointment (s)

1:00 p.m. J.J. F. - Exam Applicant – Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve applicant. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Rick Karsten, Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency Report:

- Mr. Karsten discussed the budget situation.
- Mr. Karsten shared with the Board the meeting with Misty Giles of the Governor's office about change in the application/licensing fees.

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Anita O. Martin, Executive Director's Report:

- Ms. Martin discussed the conference call from McKesson. Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve issuance upon clearance from Georgia Drugs and Narcotics and waiver of fee for Georgia location. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
- Mr. Palmer asked about the time frame for licensure. The Executive Director, , stated that from the time we have a complete file; it takes three to five working days. Mr. Palmer said that he thinks that is too long.

Miscellaneous:

- Mr. Wilson provided an update concerning the disaster committee; the Board's responsibility would be to assist with contacting all licensed pharmacists about the plan and administration and to assist with the approval of a CE program to train on the administration of the program. The Board wants the Training program for H1N1 Pharmacist Protocol be added to the Board's website.
- Mr. Palmer provided information about the oversight of Methadone Clinics. Mr. Palmer is working on revising rule/developing further regulations to present to the Board concerning this issue.
- Mr. Wilson reported on Return/Destruction of Drugs with Cobb County Clean and Beautiful. One Senior Center per month will be set up to accept returned drugs. This site will be monitored by the Cobb County Police and the drugs will be destroyed at the Cobb County Animal Control. Mr. McPherson expressed concern about no pharmacists being present at the location when this program is underway.
- Mr. Karsten, Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency, is working on the oxygen issue.
- Mr. Karsten also addressed the issue of Board members conducting inspections. The Attorney General's office advises against Board member involvement with inspections.
- Mr. Craig Fluck, Ms. Wanda Coggins and Ms. Penny Parker from the Examination Section spoke with the Board concerning the examination tomorrow.
- Mr. Palmer reported on CVS and central fill. Mr. Palmer asked that either a CVS representative meet with the Board or have CVS meet with the Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency and a Cognizant Board member.
- Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency received and has responded to an Open Records Request on the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program.

Mickey Tatum, Cognizant Board Member:

GDNA Case #A09-19: The Cognizant member recommended scheduling an Investigative Interview and have Pharmacist in Charge and the owner in for an interview as well. Mr. Prather made a motion to accept the cognizant's recommendation. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

GDNA Case #B-28955: The Cognizant member recommended the standard misfill #1 policy. Mr. Prather made a motion to accept the cognizant's recommendation. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

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GDNA Case #A-09-03: The Cognizant member recommended to follow up and see if she has signed her Voluntary and Surrender. Discussion of Veterinary Drugs. Mr. Prather discussed issue of veterinarians who are purchasing drugs from facilities that are not licensed in Georgia. Drugs can only be received in Georgia from facilities with a FDA Manufacturers permit and that hold a Georgia Manufacturer's license.

Rule Waiver request from Naga Summanth Kalidoss for Board Rule 480-2-.02. Mr. Palmer made a motion to approve. Mr. Tatum seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Rule Variance request from Hector George Clarke for Board Rule 480-2-.02 Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve. Mr. Palmer seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Request from Charles Posey re: Collaborative Agreement for Georgia Pharmacists. Correspondence from Karl D. Fiebelkorn. Board viewed as informational.

Draft of 2010 Board meeting dates. Mr. Tatum made a motion to accept the 2010 Board meeting dates with the change to May 12, 2010. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Request from Luman Earle re: Murriel Williamson. Mr. Tatum made a motion to deny request. Mr. McPherson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
