Mickey Tatum established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Open Session

The Board discussed requirements for registering Pharmacy Technicians including background checks, education and age. The Alabama Board of Pharmacy rules for technicians were reviewed as well. It was decided that a committee of Bill Prather and

Judy Gardner will work on drafting a rule and report back to the Board at the August Board meeting.

The Board reviewed 480-36 Retail Pharmacy requirements for Remote Prescription Drug ordering process. After review, Bill Prather made a motion for Rick Allen, Janet Wray, Steve Wilson and Al McConnell to work on this rule. Pat McPherson seconded the motion; the Board voted in favor of the motion.

*Fred Barber made a motion, Steve Wilson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§43-1-19(h) 2 and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board members Bill Prather, Judy Gardner, Al McConnell and Pat McPherson.*

At the conclusion of EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

Executive Session

Steve Wilson made a motion, Bill Prather seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve request from A.L.M. to discuss conditional reinstatement of license, and to schedule an appearance at the first available Board meeting.

Al McConnell made a motion, Steve Wilson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously that the scores on the Georgia Practical examination for Q.N.H. stand. Applicant may apply to retake the examination.

Judy Gardner made a motion, Steve Wilson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve request from J.D.W. for an appearance with the Board, and to schedule appearance for the September Board meeting.

The Board viewed letter from Medical Board regarding M.M. as informational, and no action was taken. The Board referred this matter to Georgia Drug and Narcotics Agency.

Al McConnell made a motion, Bill Prather seconded, and the board voted unanimously to advise JLC to go to University of Georgia or Florida misfill school for continuing education.

The Board reviewed packet from Kimberly Hazelwood regarding drug dispensing procedure and viewed it as informational. No action was taken by the Board.

Judy Gardner made a motion, Pat McPherson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to lift the perpetual inventory restriction of Schedule III drugs for Crystal Fain.

The Board viewed correspondence from J.T. Ricketson as informational and no action was taken.

The Board tabled request of Mary Lou Fleming, of Accreditation Commission for Health Care, Inc., regarding Specialty Pharmacy Licensing until the next Board meeting.

Bill Prather made a motion, Pat McPherson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to have a committee of Rick Allen, Janet Wray, Steve Wilson and Al McConnell work on a rule to govern remote prescription drug order processing, implementing all of the concerns brought up in the Board's discussion. The committee will bring recommendation to the September Board meeting. Publix will be scheduled for an appearance in October considering this issue. The committee will also work on rule for outlining professional responsibility for medical records when a Pharmacy closes.

Judy Gardner made a motion, Pat McPherson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to post the following Rule change:

480-23-.02 Declaratory Rulings.

The Georgia Board of Pharmacy ("Board") shall supply declaratory rulings as to the applicability of any statutory provision or of any of its rules. Requests for declaratory rulings must be in writing and the signature of the petitioner notarized. The petition must identify the rules or laws involved, the specific facts to be considered in the request, and a legal memorandum on the what the licensee or applicant thinks the answer should be under the laws, rules and facts cited. The Board shall respond to a request for a declaratory ruling within sixty (60) days of its receipt of said request except when the Board feels it would be in the best interest of the Board to seek the opinion of the Attorney General. Nothing in this paragraph shall limit or impair the right of the Board to seek advice from the Attorney General or an opinion of the Attorney General on any question of law connected with the duties of the Board. The Board shall not render a declaratory ruling on petitions on matters related to investigations or disciplinary hearings pending before it at the time of the petition. In addition, the Board may chose not to render a declaratory ruling when the question relates to a matter of pending civil or criminal legal action.

Judy Gardner made a motion, Steve Wilson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to adopt Board rule 480-13-.04 as follows:

480-13-.04(1) Absence of Pharmacist. Amended.

(1) General. When a licensed pharmacist is not physically present in the hospital and the pharmacy is closed, written policies and procedures shall be prepared in advance by the

Director of Pharmacy for the provision of drugs to the medical staff and other authorized personnel of the hospital by use of night cabinets and/or by access to the pharmacy. The policies and procedures may include the use of remote order entry pharmacist to ensure that in-patient needs are met at the hospital when a licensed pharmacist is not physically present. All policies and procedures providing for the use of night cabinets and/or access to the pharmacy when a licensed pharmacist is not physically present shall be ~~filed with~~ made available to the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy, its designee, or a representative of the Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency (GDNA), upon request.
