Mickey Tatum established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Open Session
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Bill Prather made a motion to approve the minutes as amended from the August 18, 2010 Board meeting; Pat McPherson seconded the motion. The Board voted to approve the minutes.

Steve Wilson attended the recent GPHA government affairs committee meeting and reported the following: GPPHA is considering no longer providing paper journals and may go with an online journal only.

No action was taken regarding Board Rule 480-2-.04 Examinations. However, after much discussion, Mickey Tatum proposed that Steve Wilson and Judy Gardner be a committee to evaluate the validity of the practical examination and to report back to the Board in December. Also, staff will go ahead with planning for the January practical examination. Bill Prather made a motion to accept Mr. Tatum's recommendation; Pat McPherson seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

The Board discussed Rule 480-6-A Pharmacy Technicians. Senior Assistant Attorney General Janet Wray made some recommendations on revising rule. The Board will work on rule and reconsider this rule at the next meeting.

The Board reviewed 480-36 Retail Pharmacy requirements for remote prescription drug ordering process. There are a few minor changes to be made before the Board can vote on this rule.

Judy Gardner made a motion, Fred Barber seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to post the following Rule change:

**480-23-.02 Declaratory Rulings.**

The Georgia Board of Pharmacy ("Board") may issue declaratory rulings as to the applicability of any statutory provision or of any of its rules. Requests for declaratory rulings must be in writing and the signature of the petitioner notarized. The petition must identify the rules or laws involved, the specific facts to be considered in the request, and a legal memorandum on the what the licensee or applicant thinks the answer should be under the laws, rules and facts cited. The Board shall respond to a request for a declaratory ruling within sixty (60) days of its receipt of said request except when the Board feels it would be in the best interest of the Board to seek the opinion of the Attorney General. Nothing in this paragraph shall limit or impair the right of the Board to seek advice from the Attorney General or an opinion of the Attorney General on any question of law connected with the duties of the Board. The Board shall not render a declaratory ruling on petitions on matters related to investigations or disciplinary hearings pending before it at the time of the petition. In addition, the Board may chose not to render a declaratory ruling when the question relates to pending civil or criminal legal action.

The Board received a subpoena from Tennessee requesting records. Janet Wray said this should be treated as an Open Records request. Judy Gardner made a motion to deny the request; Steve Wilson seconded the motion. The Board voted to deny the request.

Pat McPherson made a motion to draft a rule change to the Fees rule to present at the next Board meeting that would allow the license renewal fee to be waived for past and current Board members; Bill Prather seconded the motion. The Board voted to draft the rule.

**Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Report**

Rick Allen discussed the practice of retail pharmacies administering flu vaccinations and advised that the Pharmacists may not leave technicians unattended in the pharmacy and go to another part of the store to give injections.

Rick Allen reported that the Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency is having a hard time finding qualified applicants due to entry level salary.

Steve Wilson asked if there was a move to make Sudafed a Schedule 5; Rick said there is a move to make it a Schedule 5. In Miss and Oregon, Sudafed is a Schedule 3.

Bill Prather made a motion requesting that Rick Allen find out if notification could be placed on the GPHA and GDNA websites about filling pill mill prescriptions (make sure you have patient/doctor professional relationship and for a valid medical purpose); Judy Gardner seconded the motion. The Board voted to approve the request.

**Executive Director's Report**

Lisa Durden reported that Pharmacy Interns can now apply for their intern licenses online. She is working with the Georgia schools to continue to improve this process.

*Fred Barber made a motion, Steve Wilson seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§43-1-19(h) 2 and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board members Bill Prather, Judy Gardner and Pat McPherson.*

At the conclusion of EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

**Appointments**

J.D.W. appeared before the Board to discuss reinstatement of his pharmacy license. A motion was made by Steve Wilson to reinstate the license under a Public Consent Order; Ronnie Wallace seconded the motion. Voting in favor of reinstating the license under a Public Consent Order were Steve Wilson, Bill Prather, Ronnie Wallace, Judy Gardner, and Pat McPherson. Opposing the motion was Fred Barber.

M.C.P. appeared before the Board to discuss reinstatement of her pharmacy license. A motion was made by Bill Prather to reinstate the license under a Private Consent Order; Judy Gardner seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.
