Ms. Ashbee seconded and the Board voted, with the exception of Mr. Page, who recused himself from the vote regarding A.M.M.

Miscellaneous

Ms. Emm referred the members to the draft version of Emergency Rule Chapter 480-11-0.47-.11 Veterinarian Emergency Dispensing of Non-Patient Specific Compounded Preparations for Office Use to review. Discussion was held by Vice-President Mr. Stone who inquired as to whether or not this rule had been previously tabled. Ms. Emm responded by explaining this is an emergency rule that will be effective for the duration of the State of Emergency and for a period of not more than 120 days thereafter. Ms. Emm further explained this rule will allow veterinarians to dispense a 14 day supply of a compounded preparation received from a 503B as "office use only". She explained that this is temporary for the State of Emergency only. With no further discussion, Vice-President Stone made a motion to approve Emergency Rule Chapter 480-11-0.47-.11 Veterinarian Emergency Dispensing of Non-Patient Specific Compounded Preparations for Office Use. Mr. Azzolin seconded and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

Chapter 480-11-0.47-.11 Veterinarian Emergency Dispensing of Non-Patient Specific Compounded Preparations for Office Use.

(1) As a response to the current state of emergency as declared by the Governor, the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy finds the potential for imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare of Georgia citizens. This emergency rule shall go into effect based on O.C.G.A. 50-13-4(b) and shall be effective for the duration of the emergency and for a period of not more than 120 days thereafter. During the time this rule is effective, it shall replace Georgia State Board of Pharmacy Rule 480-11-.02(1)(d)1. only, the remainder of 480-11-.02 shall remain unaltered and in full effect.

(2) "Emergency Dispensing" shall mean no more than a 14 day supply dispensed for an urgent condition to an animal patient by a licensed veterinarian with a valid veterinarian-client-patient relationship when timely access to a compounding pharmacy is not available.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 2:43 p.m.
