

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT PROPOSED RULE TO THE GEORGIA STATE BOARD
OF PHARMACY RULES
RULE 480-48-.01 DEFINITIONS**

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the authority set forth below, the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter "Board") proposes a new Rule to the Georgia Board of Pharmacy Rules: Rule 480-48-.01 DEFINITIONS (hereinafter "proposed rule").

This notice, together with an exact copy of the proposed rule and a synopsis of the proposed rule, is being forwarded to all persons who have requested, in writing, that they be placed on an interested parties list. A copy of this notice, an exact copy of the proposed rule, and a synopsis of the proposed rule may be reviewed during normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except official State holidays, at the Department of Community Health at 2 Peachtree Street, NW, Atlanta, Georgia, 30303. These documents will also be available for review on the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy's web page at www.gbp.georgia.gov.

A public hearing is scheduled to begin at 11:00 AM on July 16, 2014 at the Georgia Board of Pharmacy, Department of Community Health, 2 Peachtree Street, 36th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30303 to provide the public an opportunity to comment upon and provide input into the proposed rule. At the public hearing, anyone may present data, make a statement, comment or offer a viewpoint or argument whether orally or in writing. Lengthy statements or statements of a considerable technical or economic nature, as well as previously recorded messages, must be submitted for the official record. Oral statements should be concise and will be limited to 5 minutes per person. Additional comments should be presented in writing. Written comments are welcome. To ensure their consideration, written comments must be received prior to July 8, 2014. Written comments should be addressed to the Executive Director of the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy at 2 Peachtree Street NW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303 FAX: 678-717-6694. You may email your comments to tbattle@dch.ga.gov.

The proposed rule will be considered for adoption by the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy at its meeting scheduled to begin at 11:05 AM on July 16, 2014 at the Georgia Board of Pharmacy, Department of Community Health, 2 Peachtree Street, 36th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30303. According to the Department of Law, State of Georgia, the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy has the authority to adopt the proposed rule pursuant to authority contained in O.C.G.A. §§ 26-4-5, 26-4-27, 26-4-28, 26-4-60, 26-4-80, 26-4-85, 26-4-110, 26-4-110.1, and 26-4-114.1.


At its meeting on June 9, 2014, the Board voted that the formulation and adoption of this rule do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of O.C.G.A. §§ 26-4-27, 26-4-28, 16-13-22.

Also, at its meeting on June 9, 2014, the Board voted that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of O.C.G.A. §§ 26-4-27, 26-4-28, 16-13-22 to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4(a)(3)(A), (B), (C) and (D). The formulation and adoption of this rule will impact every licensee in the same manner, and each licensee is independently licensed, owned and operated and dominant in the field of pharmacy.

**SYNOPSIS OF PROPOSED RULE OF THE
GEORGIA STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY RULES
RULE 480-48-.01 DEFINITIONS**

Purpose of Rule: The purpose of this rule is to define the terms used in proposed Chapter 480-48 of the Georgia Board of Pharmacy Rules.

Main Features: The main feature of this rule is to provide clear definitions of terms used in the following Rules.

480-48-.01 Definitions

For purposes of this chapter of the Rules and Regulations, the following definitions apply:

- (a) "Board" shall mean the Georgia Board of Pharmacy.
- (b) "Delivery by Mail" or "delivered by mail" shall mean delivery to a patient by the United States Postal Service or a commercial common carrier. It is not considered to be delivery by mail when a pharmacy uses its own employees or employs a local courier service to deliver filled prescriptions in the same day from the pharmacy to a patient.
- (c) "Pharmacy" means a pharmacy holding a current Board issued license to operate a pharmacy in Georgia, including pharmacy benefit managers required to be licensed pursuant under O.C.G.A. §26-4-110.1, and nonresident pharmacy permit holders.
- (d) "Mail order pharmacy" means any pharmacy which uses the mails or any other form of delivery to distribute dispensed prescription medications.
- (e) "Mail order prescription" means a prescription drug order which is dispensed pursuant to a legitimate prescription drug order under Georgia laws and rules.
