RE : PHARMACY TECHNICIANS

At its meeting on June 10, 2011, the Georgia Board of Pharmacy adopted the following policy:

“The Board has voted to amend Board Rule 480-15-.02 Registration of Pharmacy Technicians which will change the date when all pharmacy technicians are required to be registered from June 30, 2011 to August 1, 2011. As a result of the Board's proposed action, the Board has stated that it will not sanction any pharmacy or pharmacy technician for violation of the existing rule who can provide proof that the technician has submitted an application for registration as a pharmacy technician by June 30, 2011. Proof of application submission may be the receipt from the application submission or online application status checklist.”

We are processing applications in the order in which they are received. We are working diligently to ensure that all applications are processed as quickly as possible.
