Mr. Madden established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Discussion: Temporary license issuance due to disasters and Board policies: New Board Policy:

Board Policy # 10

In the September 21, 2005 Board Meeting, the Board voted to develop a policy pertaining to Emergencies/Disasters. In the September 21, 2005 Board Meeting, the Board voted to adopt the following as Board Policy:

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §26-4-80(i), the Georgia State Board of Pharmacy (Board) makes the following policy statement:

The Board voted to approve licensure by reciprocity only during Emergency/Disaster situations with the listed requirements:

- Must be declared a Federal or State disaster area
- Application/Licensure/Reinstatement fees will be waived for ninety (90) days and a temporary license issued valid through the end of the month *following* the scheduled Board meeting.
- Temporary licenses will be valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the beginning of the storm.
- Applications normally obtained from the NABP, may be obtained from GA website www.sos.state.ga.us/plb/pharmacy (licensure as registered pharmacist)

The following will be considered as acceptable identification items in order to apply for licensure/reinstatement:

- Active Pharmacist license from the affected state(s)
- Picture ID (preferably a Driver's License)
- GDNA will conduct a background check prior to approval.

For reinstatement of a GA license, the additional is waived:

- CE requirements

The Board President will approve all licenses once these items have been received by the Board office.

Email submitted by Kathy Wilson, Director, Roosevelt Institute: Mr. Prather made a motion to notify Ms. Wilson that she may not dispense medications from the Automatic Drug Dispensing Machine (ADDM) and students may not get a 7-day supply of medications without the use of proof sheets. Mrs. Gardner seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Information submitted by the NABP re: DEA clarification of existing requirements under the Controlled Substance Act for prescribing Schedule II Controlled Substances: This item was viewed as informational by the Board.

Information submitted by Compressed Gas Association re: recent legislation on the manufacture and distribution of medical gases: This information was viewed as informational by the Board.

Draft of new application, re: Limited Chemical Distributor, Board Rule 480-7(A): Mr. Barber approved the application as presented. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. See Attachment (1)

Draft of August 31, 2005 Board meeting minutes: Mr. Prather made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Tatum seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Approval to Re-Post Rule 480-10-.16, Retail & Security Systems Approval (Drive Thru): Mr. Barber moved it is the Board's opinion that the formulation and adoption of this rule does not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of O.C.G.A. § 26-4-27, 26-4-87, and 26-4-110 and that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of O.C.G.A. 26-4-27, 26-4-28, 26-4-87, and 26-4-110 to adopt or implement differing actions for business as listed at O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4(3)(A),(B),(C) & (D). The Board also states that the formulation and adoption of this rule will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned and operated in the field of Pharmacy.
