The Georgia State Board of Pharmacy met on December 10, 2008, at the Office of the Professional Licensing Boards Division, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia 31217.

Pat McPherson established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Tatum moved, Mr. Prather seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A §§43-1-19(h) (2) and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board Members, Mr. Wallace, and Mr. Wilson.

At the conclusion of the EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

APPOINTMENT (S)

- J.T.R. – The Board met with J.T.R. to discuss reinstatement of Georgia Pharmacist license. Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve J.T.R.’s request for reinstatement of Georgia Pharmacist license. The case will be forwarded to the Attorney General’s Office for a Public Consent Order. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
- J.M.S. – Cancelled – J.M.S. will have to contact the Board office to be rescheduled.
- J.R.W. – The Board met with J.R.W. and Mr. Wayne Bland & Mr. Frank Barker of Recovery Place. The Board requires J.R.W. have a cognitive function/neuro-psychological evaluation conducted to evaluate J.R.W.’s cognitive ability. A copy of the required report will be submitted to the Board for further consideration. The Board will schedule an appointment with J.R.W. and Mr. Frank Barker on January 14, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.

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Janet Wray, Attorney General's Office:

Rick Allen, Director, Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency Report:

- Several agents are currently going through Asset Seizure training.
- Reported that Rick Karsten had met with the Medical Board re: charging for investigations – viewed as informational.
- Tennessee and North Carolina have a way to track pseudoephedrine sales electronically. This federal tracking system will be implemented soon at many of the large retail stores in Georgia.
- SB10 – Will take pseudoephedrine off the exempt list and will make by prescription only.

Anita O. Martin, Executive Director's Report:

- Provided an update on the license renewal as of 12-09-08, 6836 people had renewed.
- Request from Judy Gardner to be placed on the Board's Interested Parties list. All Board members will be added.
- January 2009 meeting is in Atlanta, GA at Mercer University in conjunction with the examination.
