The Georgia State Board of Pharmacy met on February 11, 2009, Professional Licensing Board, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia 31217.

Fred Barber, Jr. established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Mr. Prather moved, Mr. Tatum seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** in accordance with O.C.G.A §§43-1-19(h) (2) and 43-1-2(k) to review applications, deliberate on disciplinary matters, and to receive information on investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board Members, Ms. Gardner, Mr. McPherson, Mr. Palmer, and Mr. Wallace.

At the conclusion of the EXECUTIVE SESSION, the Board declared an **Open Session** to vote on the matters discussed in Executive Session and to conduct other Board business.

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APPOINTMENT (S)

- G.G.S. – Reinstatement application denial appeal – The Board met with G.G.S. to discuss possible reinstatement of his Georgia Pharmacist license. Mr. Tatum made a motion to uphold denial and suggest before he can reapproach the board for reinstatement, he Must complete a 72 hours mental/psychological/physical evaluation to be completed by a physician and an addictionologist, provide acceptable CE's and remain in full child support repayment status. Mr. Prather seconded and motion carried. Mr. McPherson abstained from the vote.

- J.L.W. – Reinstatement Applicant – The Board met with J.L.W. to discuss possible reinstatement of his Georgia Pharmacist license. Ms. Gardner made a motion to approve and refer to AG's office for a Standard Impairment Consent Order. Mr. Prather seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Attorney General's Report – Ms. Janet Wray

Ms. Wray provided to the Board written advice on Recordkeeping Changes to Rules Governing Nursing Homes. Ms. Martin, Executive Director, will draft a rule revision and put the information on the March 2009 agenda.

Reinstatement Applicant – D.K.R. – Ms. Gardner made a motion to deny applicant. Applicant must meet criteria of 3A including the NAPLEX. The Board will approve you to

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work as a technician and the hours worked will apply to meet the 1,000 hour requirement. The Board is making changes to the policy and if changes made are to your benefit, the Board will consider reinstatement short of completion of 3A. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The Board will approve you to work as a technician and the hours worked will apply to meet the 1,000 hour requirement.
