Fred Barber established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

T.R.T. – Mr. Tatum made a motion to approve under a Private Impairment Consent Order. Mr. Prather seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

J.A.H. – Mr. Prather made a motion to deny applicant. Mr. Wallace seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Nader El-Kareh – Mr. Wilson made a motion to approve applicant. Mr. Wallace seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

New Day Pharmacy – Ms. Holly Pierson and Mr. Dick Waer presented information to the Board.

Omnicare Medical Arts HealthCare – Mr. Hal Henderson and Mr. Mike Sesco presented information to the Board. The process and request as presented to the Board would require a change in Georgia Law.

Rick Karsten, Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency Report:

- Michael Karnbach discussed work load balance processing and rules 480-36 with the Board. Mr. Wilson, Mr. Prather and Mr. Palmer will work with Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency to draft rules revisions to address this issue.
- Ronnie Higgins provided and discussed draft guidelines to address take home medication at Opioid Treatment Clinics. The Board suggests that the agent of the clinic must have a professional license and be an employee of the clinic and also allow take home dispensing during normal hours of operation. The take home medications and administered medications must be in 2 separate safes. Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency will draft amendments for approval by Mr. Palmer. Once the amendments are made, the Board will adopt into policy. Mr. Prather made a motion to adopt policy as amended. Ms. Gardner seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
- The Board reviewed correspondence from Adin, Gump, Strauss, Hauer & Feld – The process as cited in the letter would **not** be legal in Georgia. If any manufacturing pharmacy operates outside OCGA 26-4-60 and federal law; the pharmacies license in Georgia may be in jeopardy.
- Jerry Walker provided an update on the prescription drug monitoring program. The new name will be GA ROCS – Reporting of Controlled Substances. Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency has continued to contact Representative Sharon Cooper about this issue. Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency will be asking for an extension to the federal grant which expires in December 2009.

Anita O. Martin, Executive Director's Report:

- Ms. Martin discussed a possible renewal question for consideration, *Since the date of your last renewal, have you been in a treatment program?*
- Ms. Martin discussed on-line applications.
- Mr. Palmer shared concerns some Board members have on the condition and looks of the wall certificates. The Board would like to have the ability to provide a certificate with a raised seal to licensees.
